DOVE International's Next Chapter





fter over forty years in leadership, Larry and LaVerne Kreider believe it is time to release a younger generation of leadership to lead the DOVE International family of churches. The DOVE International Apostolic Council and leaders around the globe have confirmed this. We are excited as we prepare for the next chapter in the DOVE International story which includes leadership succession from Larry Kreider, our international director, to Merle Shenk. We anticipate Merle will take up this role in early 2024. We each have a part to play in this journey. Here is what we see our God doing among us to prepare for the future for our family of churches.

REAT JOY is released when committed believers serve God together for multiple generations. Psalm 145:4 tells us, "One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts." Ecclesiastes 3:1 states, "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens." Life comes in seasons, or, could we say, in chapters. After forty-two years, our global family of churches, DOVE International, is preparing to enter our third chapter. Let me explain.

DOVE Chapter One 1980 to 1995

DOVE's first chapter started in the late 70s and early 80s when a group of us were involved in a youth movement where hundreds of young people submitted their lives to Christ and were baptized with the Holy Spirit. In October 1980, about twenty-five people gathered in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, USA. A new church was born: DOVE Christian Fellowship. DOVE is an acronym for "Declaring Our Victory Emmanuel."

This first chapter lasted over fifteen years as we grew to become a multi-site church of more than two thousand people meeting in 130 small groups. We learned biblical foundations from Scripture focused on the three-stranded cord of prayer, evangelism, and discipleship. We were hungry to learn. We sent youth mission teams around the world. It was a privilege for me to serve as senior pastor of this exciting church. Churches were also planted in Scotland, Brazil, Kenya, Uganda, and New Zealand. Eventually it became apparent to us that the Lord was calling us to begin a second chapter in our story.

DOVE Chapter Two 1996 to 2024

DOVE chapter two began in January 1996 when our multi-site church in Pennsylvania was decentralized to become eight autonomous churches. Churches that were planted in Kenya, Uganda, and New Zealand also desired to join this new movement. These eleven churches formed the new DOVE International family of churches. I was honored to be asked to lead the International Apostolic Council as

the international director. Our vision was—and still is—simple. We are called to build a relationship with Jesus, with one another, and transform our world from house to house, city to city, and nation to nation.

Over the past twenty-six years, by God's grace, our global family of churches has grown to more than 1,200 churches in twenty-five nations. Thousands of people meet in small groups and house churches to experience spiritual family relationships and the blessing of having and becoming spiritual fathers and mothers.

One of our highlights each year is meeting together from around the globe at our International Leadership Conference. DOVE leaders also gather together at other times each year in their own nations and regions

to learn together, experience God together, and build relationships in the spiritual family.

DOVE Chapter Three

In 2016, LaVerne and I felt impressed by the Lord that we should start the process of identifying the next international director for



the DOVE family. With confirmation from the International Apostolic Council, we formed an international director succession advisory team in early 2017. By 2021, it became clear that the Lord was calling Merle Shenk to become our new international director and lead us into DOVE chapter three starting in early 2024.

Merle and Cheree spent eleven years church planting in South Africa and currently lead Newport Church, a DOVE partner church in Elm, Pennsylvania. In addition to these experiences, the Lord had alerted Merle and Cheree regarding this new leadership role through a number of prophetic words. During the two-

year transition and training period, we plan for Merle to travel with me to various nations to connect with the DOVE family globally.

We envision the opening of DOVE chapter three in early 2024 with Merle being commissioned as the new international director. Merle

intends to continue serving as the lead pastor of Newport Church as well. LaVerne and I will step off the International Apostolic Council in early 2024 to make room for younger apostolic leaders. We will continue to serve in a founder's role in DOVE. We plan to continue to provide resources for the body of Christ and serve as a spiritual father and mother to various leaders in the DOVE family and beyond.

We thank God for the past forty-two years. We are excited about the future of DOVE as we prepare for DOVE chapter three. As God's people experienced great blessing when Joshua took the reins of leadership from Moses, we expect great blessing to be released throughout the DOVE global family with new leadership in DOVE chapter three. The best is yet to come!


THE DOVE FAMILY prepares for increase






