In Acts 4, Luke highlights that a unique and abundant measure of grace was poured out over the early church. The result? A praying,




"from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love."





Safety restored in a Kenyan village

■ n Kenya, two tribes were in conflict, and people were killed. DMA missionaries Nelson and Winnie learned that a prominent witch doctor would visit their village to carry out rituals believed to protect people so that they could return home. Nelson was invited to the meeting but did not go.

"That night, I heard a knock on our door," Nelson writes. "Was this the end for us? Outside stood a group, which included the man who had invited me to the witch doctor's meeting. They told me they were coming secretly to ask that I pray for the village. Although they were pretending to depend on the witch doctor's powers, they knew in their hearts who could really protect them. God in his mercy has restored peace!"

Learning from Native American peoples of Turtle Island

urtle Island is the name for North America preferred by its Indigenous peoples. Gene and Bethanie Stevenson are missionaries with DOVE Mission International, serving among others, Native American communities in the American southwest. With Joe, an Apache brother, Gene has begun The Good Neighbor Project to facilitate understanding and partnership ministry among Native peoples and North Americans of other heritages. In April and August 2025, this project plans two land-based learning experiences to help Christians of different backgrounds walk and serve together in unity. 
Guatemala/USA partnership delivers medical care and sees people accept Christ

t the end of 2024, a connection formed between DOVE Mission International USA and DOVE in Guatemala to produce the first DOVE medical outreach in that nation in five years. Pastors Julio and Jodi Rodriguez from Light and Life Ministries were thrilled to partner with DOVE Mission International to see this come about. The whole church got involved, advertising the clinics and handing out free clothes from the church's clothing bank. These church volunteers, along with the medical team members, prayed for individuals who came to the clinic. They saw over 100 people dedicate or rededicate their lives to the Lord!

Local doctors and dentists attended over 500 patients. The team sent by DMI assisted these local professionals, filled prescriptions, and led Bible crafts for the children at the clinics.
